

NYKCCC Intern FAQ Sheet

What kind of training will I receive?

Each intern will have a trainer who will help them to develop in ministry and personal growth.

When does an internship begin and end?

Internships begin at the same time the intern's team reports in the fall, about two weeks before classes begin on the assigned campus(es). It lasts through the following summer when the intern will attend a summer project.

How much support would I have to raise?

The amount of support interns will have to raise is determined by the cost of living at their specific location. It can range from \$2,000 to \$2,500 monthly.

Where will I be placed?

Placement for interns is based largely on where the applicant requests to be placed. Other consideration that will be taken into account is that we will place interns where they will serve with a full-time staff and where they will adequately be trained and cared for.

If I go to a different location from where I currently live, how do I find housing at my assignment?

Housing is something that interns are responsible to find for themselves. The staff at each location can be a wealth of resources to help find housing, but it is ultimately up to the intern to find a home.

What does an intern do?

What an intern does on a daily basis varies based on what type of team they are on, whether a Field Ministry Team or a Regional Office Team.

What's the difference between an internship and staff?

For the most part an intern is the same as a new staff member. One notable difference is that interns commit to only one year serving with Korea Campus Crusade while a staff member commits to 3 years (including their GCTC time). Also, due to the shortened commitment interns have less support to raise and begin their ministry quicker. The training and responsibilities of an intern and a new staff member are the same.

When is the application deadline?

The application deadline is March 4th to start an internship the following fall.
