- Application fee** of \$60 dollars for early registration by **February 19th, 2010**.
The fee will be increased to **\$80** after February 28th, 2009.
(The fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.)

Application deadlines : **1st term – March 2, 2010; 2nd term – April 1, 2010**

You can hand in your COMPLETED application to your campus staff or at Gethsemane, and you can also mail it in to P.O. Box 466, Fort Lee, NJ 07024

Dear Parent and/or Guardian,

Greetings! My name is Nam Ju Chun and I am the New York Director of Korea Campus Crusade for Christ in America (KCCC).

I am writing you because your child has expressed interest in participating in a summer missions project with KCCC. We are thrilled at your child's interest and would like to share with you briefly about our ministry and the project your son/daughter is applying for.

KCCC is an extended ministry of Campus Crusade for Christ International (www.ccci.org), an inter-denominational Christian organization founded in 1951 with the purpose of helping to fulfill the Great Commission (Matthew 28:18-20). Today, Campus Crusade has more than 100,000 staff members and volunteers working in 182 countries worldwide. KCCC was the first international branch of Campus Crusade, founded by Dr. Joon Gon Kim. In the 1980s, KCCC in America, the ministry that will sponsor the missions project, was founded. We are geared toward reaching Korean-American students and mobilizing them for the fulfillment of the Great Commission. We see ourselves as an extension of the local church, working closely with pastors and churches throughout the world.
